Public hearings to be held Monday on the City of Erie's FY 2023 Annual Action Plan

Erie, PA – The City of Erie is currently preparing its Annual Action Plan for FY 2023 for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG). Two public hearings will be held on Monday at 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. The purpose of these hearings is to obtain the views and comments of residents, social service agencies, and other interested parties relative to housing and community development needs that may be addressed by CDBG, HOME, and ESG funds during the next fiscal year.

Applications opened in December 2022 for CDBG, ESG, and HOME Funds. City officials interviewed grant applicants in February.

The City of Erie expects to publish a summary of its proposed Annual Action Plan for FY 2023 on March 17, 2023. A Draft of the Annual Action Plan will be put on display for 30 days at the City of Erie, Community Centers, Blasco Library, and the City of Erie's website.
