E. ORDINANCES: FOR FINAL PASSAGE

1. Council File No. 16,551 Pending Official File Ordinance No. 61-2025 An ordinance Amending the Codified Ordinances of the City of Erie, **Article 144.02** by amending subsection (j) to (j)(1) and to add subsection (j)(2) as to the use of city owned vehicles by police officers.

2. Council File No. 16.556 Pending Official File Ordinance No. 62-2025 An ordinance authorizing an increase in the non-electoral debt of the city of Erie, Erie county, Pennsylvania by authorizing and approving the issuance and sale in the aggregate principal amount not-to-exceed \$52,350,000.00 general obligation bonds, series of 2025 (the "2025 bonds") for the purposes recited herein; directing the city clerk to prepare, certify and file the required debt statement and to take all other necessary action; covenanting that the city shall include the amount of annual debt service in its budget for each fiscal year; providing for registered bonds, date of the bonds and payment dates; providing for facsimile signatures, seal and authentication; approving the form of the bonds, paying agent's authentication certificate, endorsement and registration; providing for temporary bonds; providing for the maximum stated principal maturity amounts and fixing the maximum rates of interest on the bonds; awarding the bonds at private sale; creating sinking funds; authorizing the proper officers of the city to contract with a bank for its services as a sinking fund depository and paying agent; authorizing and directing the city clerk to certify and file with the department of community and economic development certified copies of the necessary proceedings; covenanting that the proceeds of the 2025 bonds shall not be used in such manner as to cause the 2025 bonds to be arbitrage bonds under federal tax law provisions; authorizing the proper officers of the city to do all things necessary to carry out the ordinance; providing for municipal bond insurance; and rescinding all inconsistent ordinances.

Council File No. 16,552 Pending Official File Ordinance No. 63-2025 An ordinance approving the plan of the **Erie sewer authority** for the issuance of an aggregate amount not to exceed **\$68,460,000.00** sewer revenue bonds, series of 2025 and setting forth the amount, interest rates and maturity dates of the bonds; authorizing the authority to proceed with the plan of financing; authorizing the execution and delivery of a lease agreement and the incurrence of lease rental debt thereby; authorizing the specified officers of the city of Erie to prepare and certify the debt statement, and to do all other acts necessary to carry out the provisions of the ordinance; setting forth the payment of the sewer revenue bonds and the source of such payments; repealing all inconsistent ordinances and providing that the ordinance is effective immediately.

A resolution that proper officials of the City of Erie are hereby authorized and directed to enter into agreement with <u>Berkheimer</u> of Bangor, PA for the City of Erie, TO APPOINT A LIAISON BETWEEN IT AND BERKHEIMER, THE DULY APPOINTED COLLECTOR OF LOCAL TAXES FOR THE DISTRICT, FOR THE EXPRESS PURPOSE OF SHARING CONFIDENTIAL TAX INFORMATION WITH THE DISTRICT FOR OFFICIAL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Act No. 511 of the 1965 General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (53 P.S. §690l et seq.), enacted December 31, 1965, and effective January 1, 1966, authorizes certain political subdivisions, including City of Erie, Erie County, PA, to provide for the creation of such bureaus or the appointment and compensation of such officers, clerks, collectors and other assistants and employees as may be deemed necessary for the assessment and collection of taxes imposed under the authority of that Act; and

WHEREAS, City of Erie, PA has entered into contractual agreement with BERKHEIMER of Bangor, Pennsylvania, whereby and whereunder appointed Berkheimer to collect certain local taxes; and

WHEREAS, said Act 511 specifically mandates that any information gained by the appointed tax officer, his agents or by any other official or agent of the taxing district, as a result of any declarations, returns, investigations, hearings or verifications required or authorized by the taxing municipality's ordinance or resolution, be kept confidential, except for official purposes; and

WHEREAS any person who divulges any information which is confidential under the provisions of any ordinance or resolution, upon conviction may be subject to fines and/or imprisonment, upon conviction, and dismissal from office or discharge from employment; and

WHEREAS, Berkheimer requires passage of a resolution by the governing body of City of Erie, PA, specifying that said confidential information is needed for official purposes and absolving Berkheimer from any liability in connection with the release of said confidential information;

Be it further resolved that:

- 1.the City Council does hereby appoint as its authorized representatives to make requests upon and receive any and all tax information and records from Berkheimer, relative to the collection of taxes for the City of Erie, PA, as desired and deemed necessary by the City of Erie, PA, to be used for official purposes only; and 2. Berkheimer is hereby directed to provide and/or transmit any and all tax information and records, or any portion thereof, relating to the collection of taxes for the City of Erie, PA upon request, to Lisa Gomersall, Finance Director and Melissa Rizzo, Asst. Finance Director representative for it. as the authorized contact
- 3. City of Erie, PA hereby saves harmless, indemnifies and/or absolves Berkheimer from and against any and all liability in connection with the release of said confidential information.
- 5. A resolution that proper officials of the City of Erie are hereby requested by County of Erie Bureau of Revenue & Tax Claim to remove the taxes, penalties and interest for the years indicated, as well as taxes for all future years on the following deleted trailers and invalid parcels identified by the County of Erie Bureau of Assessment on their determination of no value or non-existence of each per field review:
