- E. ORDINANCES: FOR FINAL PASSAGE**

**ORDINANCES: FOR FIRST READING**

**1. Council File No. 16,583**

An ordinance amending Article 1501, 1503.21, and 1503.27 of the U.C.C. Ordinance adopting the 2021 UCC and Chapter 11 and Appendix B of the 2021 International Building Code (IBC) for new construction along with the accessibility provisions contained in the 2021 Existing International Existing Building Code (IEBC), the 2021 International Plumbing Code (IPC), and/or the 2021 International Swimming Pool and Spa Code (ISPSC) as adopted by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania on or about January 1, 2026.

**2.. Council File No. 16,584**

An ordinance of the city council of this city of Erie (the “city”) determining to incur lease rental debt; evidenced by the guaranteed revenue bond in the maximum principal amount of **\$370,884.00** to be authorized and issued by Erie City Water Authority in connection with the construction, alteration and improvements to the public water distribution facilities in and about this city, including but not limited to, the customer side galvanized service line replacement project – phase four and paying related costs, fees and expenses; specifying the realistic useful life of the project; authorizing and directing appropriate officers of the city to take certain actions and to execute certain documents, including a guaranty agreement, between the city, as guarantor and the Erie City Water Authority, and the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority; approving the form, maximum guaranteed amounts and sources of payment of the guaranty agreement, creating a sinking fund in connection with such guaranty obligations and appointing a sinking fund depository; and providing for the repeal of all inconsistent ordinances or parts of ordinances.

**3.. Council File No. 16,585**

An ordinance Amending the following sections of Article 112, **Rules of Council**, and more specifically, §112.01(b). **Caucus Meetings**, to improve the efficiency and time involved in the legislative process for City Council.

**4. Council File No. 16,586**

An ordinance [appropriating](#) the sum of **\$140,000.00** from unappropriated and anticipated revenue to be received from the Business Development Revolving Loan Fund for utilization in the Flagship/Commodore Fund.

**5. Council File No. 16,587**

An ordinance appropriating the sum of **\$25,000.00** from unappropriated and unanticipated revenue received from Eriez Manufacturing for the expenditure thereof the **Police Capital Improvement Fund Projects**.

**6. Council File No. 16,588**

An ordinance appropriating the sum of **\$15,000.00** from unappropriated and unanticipated revenue for the expenditure thereof (contribution is from the Mercy Terrace Apartments) for the purchase of **police, fire and winter maintenance equipment**.

**7. Council File No. 16,589**

An ordinance appropriating the sum of **\$389,218.37** from unappropriated and unanticipated revenue for the expenditure thereof the **Police Capital Improvement Fund Projects**.

**8.. Council File No. 16,590**

An ordinance to repeal Ordinance 58-2025, which approved and/or authorized a ballot referendum on whether or not a commission needed formed to study and/or to recommend any changes to the City of Erie's existing form of government.

3. A resolution that Erie City Council received the Public Official **Bond** No. 108394752, from Travelers Casualty and Surety Company of America as submitted by City Controller, **Brooke Sanfilippo**, in the amount of \$200,000.00 is hereby received and placed on file in the City Clerk's Office.
4. A resolution that the proper City officials are authorized and directed to enter into an **Easement** Agreement with [Troy Sterrett Properties LLC](#), 416 State Street, Erie, PA 16507 for the installation of two signs at **416 State Street** (Index No. 4002-202). The signs will extend into the State Street right-of-way in accordance with the project drawing, as prepared by the applicant (Larry Franco).
5. A resolution that the proper City officials be and are hereby authorized and directed to execute an Easement Agreement between the City of Erie and [Erie Insurance](#), 144 E. 6th St., Erie, PA 16530 being the owner of **402 French St**, Index (14) 1002-205, in compliance with the attached City Engineer's metes and bounds description locating a ramp and step with railing as well as an awning.
6. That Erie City Council will conduct a **public hearing** to consider testimony regarding the request to designate the [Erie Cemetery](#), located at **2116 Chestnut Street**, Erie, PA as a **Historic Site**. The City Clerk is authorized and directed to advertise notice of a Public Hearing to be held before City Council on Wednesday, February 4, 2026 at approximately 9:30 A.M. in City Council Chambers, 626 State Street, Erie, PA pursuant to Ordinance 80-2005, the City of Erie Zoning ordinance, as amended.
7. A resolution that Bill Heiden, City Traffic Engineer, is hereby authorized and directed to sign the [Green Light-Go](#) Program Grant/Reimbursement Agreement between the City of Erie and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation and to execute all future documents related to the following Project:

**Green Light-Go Program PennDOT Project, W. 12th St and Pittsburgh Ave Signal Upgrades**

The total estimated project cost is \$932,900.55, with \$746,320.44 coming from PennDOT.

The Municipal share is 20% of the project total and estimated to be \$186,580.11
